While Tom Fazio is best known for creating massive landscapes for his designs, Spring Hill required little manipulation of earth. Fazio utilized the existing rolling topography to form what is one of his most natural designs. Holes are isolated from one another by thick forests of evergreens and, in one section of the property, acres of maple trees

that provide a brilliant color display each fall. With several tight fairways, marshland along some edges, many uphill approach shots into elevated greens and subtle movements in the putting surfaces, Spring Hill is also one of Fazio's most challenging designs. The E Scow World in the 2010s and Beyond

- 📅 2010: January 3. Apple releases the first iPad.
- 📅 2010: On the agenda of the NCESA Development Committee: a fully ballasted mainsail with a fuller roach, and carbon-fiber spars.
- 📅 2012: Osama Bin Laden is killed in a raid by US armed forces.
- 📅 2013: Melges Boat Works reworks its deck mold. Major changes include moving the board system under the deck and a new sprinkler launching system.
- 📅 2011: Fukushima, Japan, is devastated by a powerful earthquake, resulting in a tsunami. A nuclear power plant in Fukushima melts down.
- 📅 2016: The E Scow season opens in the North with Peter Glöckner winning two races and edging Vincent Porter at the Geneva Spring Regatta.
- 📅 2015: A trike-out Chevy Silverado E-Scow towing machine could be bought for almost \$52,000.
- 📅 2016: The Chicago Cubs defeat Cleveland in the 10th inning of Game 7 of the World Series. This ends the longest victory world championship drought in the history of baseball.
- 📅 2017: At the ILYA E Invitational on Pewaukee, a non-cooked discussion ensues regarding the merits of the "old days," when the E Invite was only five races, and was therefore, somehow better. Had it been 5 races, Tom Burton would have won by an even larger margin.
- 📅 2018: The Miss America Pageant eliminates the swim suit competition from its judging categories.
- 📅 2021: NCESA Nationals: Harry Melges IV survives a black flag disqualification in race 2 to edge Sam Rogers by one point.

The America's Cup Sailors Come to the Blue Chip
 The E Scow Blue Chip is always a special regatta, in part because of the inclusion of a Mystery Guest from the elite ranks of the international sailing world. The decade of the 2010s saw an influx of sailors from the America's Cup, bringing celebrity star power and great sailing to the event, also highlighting E Scow-grown world-class talent, like Andrew Campbell, Team Oracle crew member and third-generation E Scow sailor, following father Bill and grandfather Cliff Campbell.

In 2012, Peter Isler (right), a 2-time America's Cup winner as Navigator aboard Dennis Conors' Stars and Stripes, was one such elite sailor who thoroughly enjoyed the process. Like many Mystery Guests, rock star status doesn't always translate to success on the water—Isler finished 13th. But, as he wrote in the Reporter, "Nobody at Pewaukee VC seems to put too much of import on the MG's regatta score...it's all about showing the Mystery Guest a real good time."



Fresh off his remarkable America's Cup comeback in 2013, Jimmy Spithill (left) came to Pewaukee in 2014 for the 49th Blue Chip. Teamed with Jim Campbell, David "Buckaroo" Buckley, and Lesa Guttenkunst, Spithill started strong, working toward a top-5 finish when he put it in the creek in Race 5. He finished 8th overall. Busy cresting his own celebrity status during the regatta was Harry Melges IV, who won all six races and prompted Spithill to say that H4 was "at another level." Spithill's good heart was fully on display during the regatta as he spent time with the PVC Sailing School kids—making memories for a lifetime.

2015 marked the 50th Anniversary of the Blue Chip, and PVC pulled out all the stops, inviting all the past Mystery Guests back to sail and celebrate. The list of Skipper's read like a Who's Who of Olympic and America's Cup sailing, including Dave Perry, Paul Cayard, Jonathan McKee, Dave Ullman, Cam Lewis, Betsy Alison, Gary Jobson, Mark Reynolds, and the eventual winner, Bora Gulari. These luminaries were joined by NCESA and ILYA Legends, and the competition was as fierce as it was fun. Little wonder these sailing greats rose to the top of their classes—they are very, very competitive.

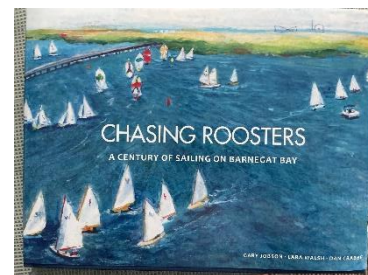
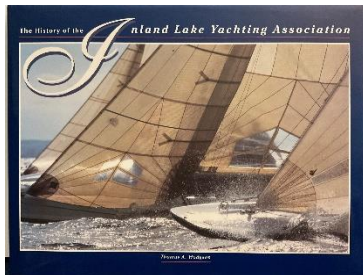
